PURPOSE

The purpose of the Templeton CLT Scholarship is to direct a major merit-based scholarship to a student who cares deeply about the classical tradition and has excelled in their academic studies. Templeton offers one of the most selective and academically rigorous Christian great books programs in the country. We challenge outstanding students to steward their gifts faithfully in community, so they may continue to grow in all things through Christ our Lord.

DESCRIPTION

The Templeton CLT Scholarship includes a \$25,000 annual scholarship for four years of undergraduate study at the Templeton Honors College.¹ Joining the cohort of first-year Templeton students, the CLT Scholar will also be paired with a leading professional in a field related to the scholar's area of study. This Christian mentor will be a resource for encouragement and assistance throughout the student's undergraduate education.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Acceptance into the undergraduate program at Eastern University: www.eastern.edu
2. A CLT score of 100 or above.
3. A demonstrated record of leadership
4. Academic standing in the top 9% of graduating class (where applicable)
5. 2020 high school/homeschool graduate.

¹The CLT Scholarship reflects Eastern University's top scholarship award of \$20,000, plus an additional \$5,000 from the Templeton Honors College. Eastern University's policy for scholarships and grants does not permit this scholarship to be stacked with other merit-based scholarships, or with the Young Life or Fellowship of Student Athletes Grants. Need-based aid is also calculated after all merit-based awards are considered, rather than independently of them.
